Up to 70% of all lower limb amputations globally are in diabetics, with an amputation somewhere in the world every 30 seconds, some 85% of which are believed to be preventable through proper wound care. Nearly half of the individuals who have an amputation due to vascular disease will die within 5 years. This is higher than the five year mortality rates for breast cancer, colon cancer, and prostate cancer.

In work done at The Mayer Institute, a leading center for advanced diabetic wound treatment, Delivra's transdermal cream delivery system is at the core of a new therapeutic modality that has shown promising results for diabetic patients. Specifically, the tetracycline antibiotic known as doxycycline hyclate, has been formulated in the Delivra system for application to diabetic, lower limb wounds.
