



New Investigator Award

The New Investigator Award will be presented for outstanding abstract submission accepted for inclusion at the conference authored by a new investigator. This is your chance to present at Canada's premier wound care meeting and make a name for yourself in the field of wound care. To qualify and support your application to be considered for the award, you must:

1. Submit an abstract by midnight of January 27, 2019 (EDT) that follows abstract submission guidelines and that has not been previously published.
2. Indicate by checking the appropriate box during submission that you wish to be considered for the New Investigator Award.
3. Be the primary author of and have made significant contributions to the research described in the submitted abstract.
4. Have completed the research as partial fulfillment of a postgraduate degree program (masters degree, Nurse Practitioner, Doctor of Medicine or Doctor of Philosophy), postgraduate course/certificate (Nurses Specialized in Wound, Ostomy and Continence Canada, International Interdisciplinary Wound Care Course), or while a postdoctoral fellow or resident.
5. Not currently hold part-time or full-time appointment at an academic institution at a rank of assistant professor or higher; not held an academic position of any type for more than four years.
6. Agree to attend the fall conference of Wounds Canada to present the research work described in the abstract.
7. Submit a letter outlining your career plans and commenting on how these plans will promote/increase the research activities of Wounds Canada. This must be submitted along with your abstract by January 27, 2019.
8. Submit a letter of reference from your mentor or supervisor providing proof of your current registration in a postgraduate program or course, verifying your contribution to the research work, and commenting on your research potential. Your supervisor's full contact information—address, phone number, email—must be included, so that he/she may be contacted to support your application. This must be submitted along with your abstract by January 27, 2019.

Awards will not be given to individuals unless they provide all of the information noted above at the time of abstract submission and fulfill all of the stated qualifications.
