

Research Assistant x2

30 hours per week for 12 weeks

Wounds Canada is hiring two Research Assistants. The students will work independently and collaboratively to engage in activities that complement their current undergraduate education. They will have the opportunity to explore in depth the research domain of healthcare. Specifically, the students will target a primary research foci within the scope of available projects and have the opportunity to engage in the following research activities:

- ethics submission
- systematic literature reviews
- data collection (participant interviewing, chart review, anthropometric assessments, etc.)
- descriptive data analysis (qualitative and quantitative)
- preparation of a poster presentation
- seminar presentations
- scientific reporting

These positions will provide students with the opportunity to develop an understanding of the research process and its importance in health care, and to experience the collaborative nature of research. The knowledge and skills learned will enhance those attained in the undergraduate program and increase the student's understanding of research and research roles in healthcare.

Skills/Qualifications Required:

This position is open to undergraduate students, medical students, allied health students or Nursing students who have completed at least two years of their undergraduate program and have an interest in Research. Students are not expected to have extensive research experience, but should demonstrate the following duties and responsibilities:

- Ability to work semi-independently under the direction of researchers and coordinators
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills
- Strong writing skills

Familiarity with word processing and data management software (i.e., Word, Excel) This role is open to youth ages 30 and under as part of the Canada Summer Jobs Program.
