

### Wound Healing Courses at Cardiff University

An estimated 1 to 2% of the population in developed countries will experience a chronic wound during their lifetime.<sup>1</sup> In addition, the increase in older individuals—as well as the upsurge in the prevalence of diabetes—is likely to add to the burden that wounds place on society. Currently, undergraduate medical and health-care training does not fully prepare graduates to deal with this vast subject. Cardiff University runs several wound healing courses that help fill this gap.

The Wound Healing courses at Cardiff University have led the field of wound healing-related postgraduate education since 1996. Students can study from stand-alone Wound Healing Foundation Modules up to MSc level (Wound Healing and Tissue Repair MSc).
